ANNOUNCEMENT NON RECURRING SHORT-TERM BENEFITS (NRSTB)

If you have been impacted by the recent Coronavirus pandemic and/or other emergency situations, the North Fork Rancheria Tribal TANF (NFRTT) program has a new benefit that you may be eligible for called the Non-Recurring Short-Term Benefit (NRSTB). If you reside in any of the NFRTT's seven California counties of Madera, Fresno, Mariposa, Merced, Monterey, San Benito or San Luis Obispo, you may be eligible for the (NRSTB) if you meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Have an eligible Native American/Alaska Native child in the home.
- Reside in the seven county service area of Fresno, Madera, Mariposa, Merced, Monterey, San Benito or San Luis Obispo County.
- Have income equal to or less than 300% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines for the size of your family.

If you are interested in applying for this benefit, please complete the online application and email it, complete the online application and mail it or contact any of the NFRTT offices so it can be mailed to you.

Once the application has been received, a Case Manager will be in contact with you within 24- hours Monday through Friday 8:0am to 5:00pm.
